Searching the Internet





Beware!! If it seems too good...

- •"Work-at-home" appears in heading
- Unsolicited job offers (via email)
- •"No experience necessary!"
- Payment required (jobs, not businesses)
- Unrealistic salary
- Vague information
- No request for a resume or bio
- •"Hiring 17 people!"
- "Christian Company"
- •Palm trees, beaches, sports cars!


